Credit System

A fulltime study load at TUM SOM is approximately 1800 hours per year which is equal to 60 ECTS credits. Usually German students to undertake a workload of 30 credits per semester. For exchange students, we recommend a workload of 15-20 ECTS per semester. 1 ECTS credit represents approximately 30 working hours. These hours include all work required for completing the course: lecture, exercises, cases, possible projects, independent studies, exams etc. The contact time in class per week is 30 minutes for 1 ECTS. A semester usually consists of 15 weeks of lecture period.
